

Granite ~ Fat Quarter Cut-Ups Supply List

Finished Size: 61 ¼” x 68” (56 - 6 ¾” blocks)

Fabric Requirements and Cutting Instructions:

(Please have fabric cut prior to class)

Dark Fabric, 7 fat quarters:

Cut into (28) 9” squares (for Block Construction)

Light Fabric, 2 ½ yards: Cut into (28) 9” squares (for Block Construction) and for First Border – Cut 6 strips 1 ½” x WOF

Final Border 2 ¼ yards: Cut 2 strips 6 ½” x 60”, lengthwise cut for sides and Cut 2 strips 6 ½” x 65” lengthwise cut for top and bottom

Supply List Pattern: **Provided by Brenda from her**

Book “Fat Quarter Cut-Ups 2”

- Sewing Machine (cleaned & in good working order)
- Thread to blend with fabrics - dark grey or khaki work well
- Rotary Cutter
- Cutting Mat
- Finger Presser
- Scissors
- Seam Ripper
- Pins
- Ruler -a 14” ruler for the sub-cuts and a 8” square to trim the completed blocks



Classroom Store:

I will have available for purchase in the classroom a few of the supplies necessary for class: finger pressers and a few basic notions. Some of these items may be difficult to find at your local shops because their use may not have “caught-on” in all locales.

Fabric Note: Please press the F.Q.s and Light Fabric with spray starch for stability!! I use Sta-Flo concentrated spray starch mixed 1 to 1 with water in a spray bottle. This will give the fabric added crispness that will make piecing and pressing easier.
