### “Cottage Garden”



Create a beautiful beginner mixed medium using paints, Aida cloth, yarn, and ribbon. This small English cottage is a charming piece that can be framed as a painting or incorporated into a crazy quilt project. Can be found on page 18 in "Floral Stitches" book. Judith will supply paints for anyone who doesn't have their own.

#### Supplies:

- 5" x 7" picture matt, (opening) **MUST BRING!!!**
  - Small count Aida cloth (white) 6" x 8"
  - Pellon fleece, 2 pieces, 6" x 8"
  - Fine permanent pens – brown and black
  - Sharp mechanical pencil
  - Water erasable pen
- Watercolor paints – blue, umber, yellow, red, - optional as Judith will have paints available
  - 2 Medium watercolor brushes
  - Yarns – gold, greens and mauves (variegates are best)
  - 4 mm silk variegated ribbon, variety of flower colors
  - Variety embroidery threads, in greens and flower colors
  - Tacky glue
  - Beads, Nymo thread
  - Variety of needles (chenille, tapestry and embroidery)

#### PLUS:

This basic supply list is what I think all students should always bring to any needlework or quilting class, regardless of the actual class supply list. It is a good idea to keep these supplies in a small container for convenience.

Needles: Darning, #10 Sharps, Beading, Crewel, Chenille, Tapestry and Embroidery

Paper and pencil for notes

Washout markers

White marking pencil, mechanical pencil

Tacky glue and glue stick

Measuring tape, see-through ruler, straight pins

Paper and fabric scissors

Green embroidery thread and gray sewing thread

Embroidery hoop 6"

Art paper for sketches and patterns
