**Pepper Cory** has been a quiltmaker since 1972 when she purchased a quilt at a rummage sale for \$1.00. She says she immediately fell in love and from that moment on, decided she had to learn how to quilt. Not only did she learn how to quilt, but she opened a quilt shop in East Lansing, Michigan that she operated for seven years. This launched her into teaching quilting which has meant travelling the U.S. and several foreign countries. Her quilting articles have appeared in all the best quilting magazines and she has written seven books. She also designs quilting stencils.
